#### OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Exodus 19:1-6 NLT

<sup>1</sup>Exactly three months after the people of Israel left Egypt, they came to the Desert of Sinai. <sup>2</sup> After they started out from Rephidim, they entered the Desert of Sinai. They camped there in the desert in front of the mountain.

<sup>3</sup> Then Moses went up to God. The LORD called out to him from the mountain. He said, "Here is what I want you to say to my people, who belong to Jacob's family. Tell the Israelites, <sup>4</sup> 'You have seen for yourselves what I did to Egypt. You saw how I carried you on the wings of eagles and brought you to myself. <sup>5</sup> Now obey me completely. Keep my covenant. If you do, then out of all the nations you will be my special treasure. The whole earth is mine. <sup>6</sup> But you will be a kingdom of priests to serve me. You will be my holy nation.' That is what you must tell the Israelites."

#### **NEW TESTAMENT LESSON**

John 15:1-8 NLT

<sup>1</sup> "I am the true vine. My Father is the gardener. <sup>2</sup> He cuts off every branch joined to me that does not bear fruit. He trims every branch that does bear fruit. Then it will bear even more fruit. <sup>3</sup> You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup> Remain joined to me, just as I also remain joined to you. No branch can bear fruit by itself. It must remain joined to the vine. In the same way, you can't bear fruit unless you remain joined to me.

<sup>5</sup> "I am the vine. You are the branches. If you remain joined to me, and I to you, you will bear a lot of fruit. You can't do anything without me.

<sup>6</sup> If you don't remain joined to me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and dries up. Branches like those are picked up. They are thrown into the fire and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you remain joined to me and my words remain in you, ask for anything you wish. And it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> When you bear a lot of fruit, it brings glory to my Father. It shows that you are my disciples.
