Something to ponder as you prepare for worship:

On a high mountain, Jesus was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became bright as light... and a voice from the cloud said, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!' Matt. 17:1, 5

"Transfiguration" refers to a change in form or appearance. On Transfiguration of the Lord Sunday, we celebrate the revelation of divine glory in the human life of Jesus Christ. Jesus' radiant appearance on the mountaintop evokes the consuming fire of the glory of the Lord at Mount Sinai. Standing with Moses and Elijah, Jesus represents the fulfillment of the law and the prophets. The transfiguration looks back to Jesus' incarnation and baptism, as God again claims him as a beloved child. This event also looks forward to his death and resurrection, as the one who is lifted up on the cross will reveal the glorious victory of God.
