GATHERING TOGETHER AS COMMUNITY

Something to ponder as you prepare for worship:

Because we were not able to gather for worship last Sunday, we will celebrate two Advent themes today — Joy and Love. Traditionally, the third week in Advent takes Joy as its central theme. It is sometimes called, "Guadete Sunday" (guadete means "rejoice" in Latin), or "Mary Sunday" because Mary's song of joy, the Magnificat (from Luke 1:46b-55), is substituted for the Psalm reading. We also light the rose candle in the Advent wreath as another symbol for joy. This candle breaks the penitential purple, signaling the midpoint of Advent and a shift from reflection to joyful anticipation of Christ's birth. While Advent is a time of longing and waiting in the shadows for Christ to come, there is also "anticipatory joy" in his arrival. The fourth week of Advent celebrates God's expansive and persistent Love by entering into the world with us, as the child born to Mary, Immanuel.

LIGHTING THE CANDLES OF THE ADVENT WREATH

We watch and wait for Christ's coming!

We light candles of hope, peace, joy, and love, remembering the promises of God with prayer.

We light this candle in hope.

We light this candle for peace.

We light this candle with joy.

This week, we light the candle of joy to remind us that darkness does not have the last word. Hear the words of the prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 35:1):

The wilderness and the dry land shall be glad, the desert shall rejoice and blossom.

And the song of Mary (Luke 1:46b-50):

"My soul magnifies the Lord,

and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,

for he has looked with favor on the lowly state of his servant.

Surely from now on all generations will call me blessed,

for the Mighty One has done great things for me,

and holy is his name;

indeed, his mercy is for those who fear him

from generation to generation."

We also light this candle for love. Out of love for the people of God, the Lord speaks through the prophet Isaiah 7:10-14:

The Lord spoke to Ahaz, saying, Ask a sign of the Lord your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven. But Ahaz said, I will not ask, and I will not put the Lord to the test. Then Isaiah said: "Hear then, O house of David! Is it too little for you to weary mortals, that you weary my God also? Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Look, the young woman is with child and shall bear a son, and shall name him Immanuel.
